



# Request For Extension of Decision Deadline Ready Reference ♦ F-13

In some cases you may need more time than the employer has allowed for you to make a decision on a job offer. You may ask for an extension, but the employer does not have to grant it. Make sure you have a good reason for asking for an extension. Are you waiting to hear from another employer about an offer, or are you just hoping to get more interviews? Do not wait until the last minute to ask for an extension. Doing so appears that you do not think ahead and may indicate that you might behave the same way on the job. Be tactful and diplomatic in your wording. Consult CEAT Career Services if you need assistance with your individual situation.
